

“Lower South Island Teams Racing Regatta 2011”

Timaru Yacht and Power Boat Club hosted the above Regatta on April 2nd and 3rd. Six teams participated: Christchurch Boys’ High School, Canterbury Combined Schools, Craighead Diocesan School, Timaru Boys’ High School, Mt Aspiring College A and B.

On Saturday a full round robin was completed in light conditions with Christchurch Boys’ High School, Timaru Boys’ High School, and Mt Aspiring College A finishing with 4 wins each,

Craighead Diocesan School 2 wins, Mt Aspiring College B 1 win and Canterbury Combined Schools 0 wins.

We then left the course due to lack of wind and split the fleet into Gold & Silver.

Approx 45 mins later a 12 to 14 knot easterly arrived with moderate seas and another two and a half round robins were sailed in Gold & Silver fleets.

Sunday dawned flat with no wind. However mid afternoon produced a very light breeze where we managed to complete one Gold Fleet and two Silver Fleet races to complete the fourth round robin when we had to call it a day.
