# NOTICE OF RACE

**1 RULES**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1.1 The rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*
- 1.1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA) Part 2
- 1.1.3 The Team Racing Rules (Appendix D of the RRS)

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 All competitors (both skipper and crew) shall be members of a yacht/sailing club affiliated with their National Yachting Authority in accordance with RRS46&56.
- 2.2 All teams shall consist of bona fide students from the nominating school situated in Australia or New Zealand. Entries from other countries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 2.3 If less than 3 NZ teams enter by the due date the extra place(s) will be offered to Australian teams.
- 2.4 Three teams each of any gender from Australia and New Zealand, as nominated by the Australian Team Sailing Association and the New Zealand Team Sailing Association respectively, are eligible to enter the championship.
- 2.5 Three all-girl teams from Australia and New Zealand, as nominated by the Australian Teams Sailing Association and the New Zealand Team Sailing Association respectively, are also eligible to enter the championship. Should less than three New Zealand teams enter the championship by the due date, the number of all-girl Australian teams will be increased accordingly.
- 2.6 Teams will consist of a maximum of eight (8) sailors who must be listed on the official entry form.
- 2.7 Any combination of six (6) registered team members may compete in any race, with no combination weighing less than 110kgs. Crew shall be weighed in dry T-shirt and shorts only. Crews that weigh less than the minimum combined crew weight per boat will be required to carry water ballast on board whilst racing. Ballast shall not exceed 10 kg
- 2.8 Entries on the attached Entry Form shall be lodged with RQYS together with the required entry fee and damage deposit by the entry closing date.
- 2.9 Entries close at 1700 hours on Wednesday 19 August 2015.
- 2.10 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

3.2 Damage Bond - this fee will be fully refunded after the completion of the championship entered, provided the team has not been responsible for any damage to boats or equipment, or a deduction has been made in accordance with 4.3.

**4 BOATS**

- 4.1 The championship will be sailed in Pacer type dinghies supplied by the Organising Authority.
- 4.2 The cost of damage (at commercial rates) to any boat or equipment will be charged to the team that is deemed to be responsible. In the case of damage between opposing teams both teams may be charged. Damage costs will be deducted from the damage bond of the team responsible.
- 4.3 Damage that occurs whereby the responsible team cannot be identified will result in the cost of the damage being allocated equally across all teams entered and deducted from the damage bond.

- 9.1 The format will be Round Robin as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 The Organising Authority reserves the right to alter the format at any time.

## **10 PRIZES**

- 10.1 The Inter-Dominion Schools Team Racing Trophy will be awarded to the winning team.
- 10.2 A trophy will be awarded to the winning country based on the total number of wins whenever an Australian team sails against a New Zealand team. Ties shall be broken in accordance with D4 using only those races.
