GENERAL INFORMATION

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2012 2016 including Appendix D
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The "Single Flag Protest Procedure", D2.3(a) shall be used.

2.0 Changes to Racing Rules

The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

- 2.1 Sailors are asked to accept umpires decisions as final to allow for practical management of this regatta.
- 2.2 In Rule D 5.1, change red to yellow.

3.0 Changes to Class Rules

The rules of the 420 class will be changed as follows - spinnakers and trapezes will not be permitted. Clauses 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4 also change class rules.

4.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to High School Sailing Teams.
- 4.2 To register, teams or individual sailors wishing to enter must fill in the entry form attached and send with an entry fee of \$50 per sailor to Kerikeri Cruising Club, 346 Opito Bay Road, Kerikeri prior to 1700 on Thursday 1st December 2016. [email address info@kerikericruisingclub.org.nz]. If a Team causes Damage to another team's boats etc. they must cover the cost at least up to the value of any Insurance excess before they are allowed to continue racing.
- 4.3 Late entries may be accepted; a late charge of \$50.00 per team will apply.

5.0 Boats and Equipment

- 5.1 Teams are expected to bring and use their own 420s. Boats will not be exchanged. Teams unable to supply boats should contact Derry Godbert 407 8058 or godbert@xtra.co.nz for more information.
- 5.2 Boats must be 420 dinghies fitted with NZTSA size coloured mainsails, being 200mm shorter in the leech than a standard main and the size of a Sunburst main when reefed.
- 5.3 The boats will be left at night on KCC-controlled grounds.
- 5.4 All teams are requested to supply their own red protest and yellow breakdown flags

[minimum size 200 X 150 mm] and bailers.

5.5 Buoyancy vests must be worn by competitors at all times while afloat.

The course will be right hand 'S' as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10.0 SCORING

Team Racing Scoring, Appendix D3 and D4 will apply.

11.0 COACH/SUPPORT

All teams are encouraged to bring their own coach and coach/support boat. All coach/support boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio. All individuals on such boats are required to wear PFD's. Teams unable to provide a coach or boat please contact Kerikeri Cruising Club.
