### Amendment number 1 to the Sailing Instructions

Sunday 16th April – Friday 21st April 2023

Algies Bay, Warkworth

#### Delete 7.1 and replace with

- 7.1. Weight Limitation: The two members of the crew of each boat are expected to weigh a minimum of 110kg combined. However, crews weighing between 105kg and 110kg shall make their weight up to 110kg with sand filled bottles, which shall be fixed near the mast foot when racing. These weights need to be approved and marked with school name, sailors' names and the total weight. If a pairing is close to the weight limit, they shall be permitted to be weighed in normal dry sailing gear.

#### Delete 13.2 and replace with

- 13.2. The time limit for the first boat to finish shall be 20 minutes. Boats not finishing within 10 minutes after the first boat finishes shall be scored as defined by RRS D3.1(a). **This changes RRS 35.**

#### Delete 20.3.1 and replace with

- 20.3.1. At the completion of the first round-robin there will be an automatic promotion/relegation for the top ranked 2 teams & bottom ranked 2 teams in each fleet. Then after the second round-robin an automatic promotion/relegation for the top ranked team and bottom ranked team in each fleet.

#### Delete 20.3.2 and replace with

- 20.3.2. Teams that are promoted/relegated will have their points set to zero from the first round robin and they will score double points in the next round robin. The promoted/relegated teams after the second round robin will have their points set to zero and they will score treble points in the next round robin.

#### Delete 21.1 and replace with

- 21.1. The National Championship will be awarded to the gold fleet winner and the highest placed "single school" and the highest placed "single school girls only" team. Plus, trophies shall be awarded to teams placed highest in the lower fleets.
